ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

Documents to be submitted at the time of admission

- Duly filled and signed admission form.

- Incomplete registration or admission forms will be rejected.

Documents to be submitted at the time of admission

- Blood Group Report.
- Transfer certificate (Original with Counter Sign.)
- Certificate of Date of Birth.
- Photocopy and original copy of Report Card

In case of not having Report Card or T.C. the verification letter issued by the previous school mentioning the D.O.B. and the class he / she is studying, should be attached with the admission form.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The students should come to school in proper uniform prescribed for all the students for Class First to class VIII. Students without proper uniform are not allowed to attend the school.

(A) Summer Uniform:

For Boys: Light Grey Checked shirts and Dark Grey Trousers / shorts, black shoes and white socks.

For Girls: Dark Grey skirts, light grey checked shirt, black shoes and white socks.

(B) Winter Uniform:

1. Sweater with V shaped neck both for boys and girls.
2. Blazers are compulsory for all the students with tie for both.

Please avoid meeting the teachers during the school hours, as it disturbs the study of the entire class. Parents are not allowed to visit the class - rooms during the school hours. Teachers can only be contacted on last Saturday of every month between 8.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m.

SOME BASIC ELEMENTS OF THE PHILOSOPHY OF OUR SCHOOL:

Development of aesthetic sense in children is adequately taken care of through introduction of music and other fine arts. Those who are endowed with better potentialities are taught to do more but all are encouraged to appreciate what is taught in the music and fine arts. The programme starts right from the nursery classes, where children sing rhymes, the programme continues in primary section through action songs in musical tunes and notes. In senior classes the children are taught vocal/instrumental music and dancing. It is hoped that this education may be able to bring about peace and harmony. Personality grooming activities will be done through theatre workshop.

Free expression through Drawing and Painting is also an integral part of the school education from the earliest stages. It is needless to say that all efforts are made to help the children develop their personalities.

SOCIALLY USEFUL PRODUCTIVE WORK AND ACTIVITIES / CCE PROGRAMME

Common craft such as paper folding and cutting is introduced in the primary stages. Making meaningful collections and learning their classification is done by children.

Right from the primary classes, children start learning simple craft. Their activities are continued and improved upon in the middle classes. Making working models and toys, is also taught. In senior classes workshop practice will be given. All such activities will give them competence and confidence in making use of technological development effective in their daily life.
